Friday, July 8:

1. **Welcome and Introductions:** Since the theme of our event is “Radically Transforming Community,” share what is precious to you about community.

Saturday, July 9:

1. **Gathering Prayer and State of the Heart:** In what ways have you experienced God’s unfolding love in your life, community, world?
2. **Small Group Conversations Following the Personal Integration Time:**
 - What is emerging from your experience during your personal integration time?
 - What was good for me to hear...from Lynn, from Olga? What was hard for me to hear?
 - What similarities did you hear between Lynn’s call to unioning love, an intersection of diversity, inclusion, and equity and Olga’s invitation to adopt an abolitionist framework where faith, justice, and reconciliation help to create a world where communities can flourish?
 - How does the power of sharing knowledge; of telling stories; of being in community; of dreaming and building; help to create systems outside of the ones around us, around the violence of our world?

2. **During Sunday Liturgy:** Share a grace that has been given to you during this sacred time.
